

Sinks Pharmacy: Biological Hormone Replacement Therapy (BHRT) Clinical Services

Model:

- 1. Physician identifies a patient requesting or a candidate for BHRT.
- 2. Physician will ask the patient to complete a pre-screening hormone evaluation provided by Sinks Pharmacy.
- 3. Physician may choose to prescribe independently or can send the evaluation to our pharmacist for therapy recommendation.
 - a. Once the evaluation is received, the pharmacist may reach back out to the patient for additional follow-up questions or establish the patient's top symptoms he or she would like to focus on.
- 4. Pharmacist will then submit his or her recommendation to the prescribing physician with a brief summary on a prescription template.
- 5. Physician may choose to sign the prescription as recommended or make modifications to the recommended order.
- 6. Physician's office faxes the order or electronically prescribes the order to Sinks Pharmacy St. Clair.
- 7. Sinks Pharmacy staff would notify the patient of price and arrange delivery.
- 8. Prior to refill, the patient would be contacted by the pharmacy team to determine how the patient is responding to therapy and evaluate continuing current therapy or making a dose adjustment recommendation to the physician.
- 9. Once the patient becomes stable on therapy, every effort will be made to provide the patient with a 90 day supply to provide a cost-break to the patient.
